

Koning puts name in CHS record book

CEDARVILLE — Trent Koning knows his Cedarville high school hoops history.

“There are a lot of real good players who’ve played basketball at Cedarville,” he said.

You can add Koning’s name to that list. The CHS senior scored his 1,000th career point at West Jefferson Jan. 8, becoming just the fourth player to surpass that mark at the school.

After Tuesday’s 85-49 laugher against Triad, the sharpshooter sits at 1,026 career points and should pass Greg Walker (1,135) and Matt Harner (1,141) this season. Colby Cross, who graduated in 2020, is the top scorer with 1,565

points. Koning was flattered to be listed among those three.

“It’s a real cool milestone,” he said. “It’s cool to have my name up there with them. Those guys who have been great players.”

Coach Ryan Godlove knew Koning would also be one of the all-time greats the first time he saw him.

“You have some kids that you see in junior high that you’re really excited about and Trent was one of those,” God-

love said. “Someone we’ve been excited about since day one. One of those kids you love having around your program.”

Coaches would love to have that type of player just one year. Even two. Godlove has had Koning

for four.

“Trent’s been starting for us since his freshman year,” Godlove said. “This year it’s been fun to watch him take another step forward. We’re excited for him to celebrate the hard work and effort that he’s been putting in. He’s a kid that doesn’t come along too often.”

Despite his lofty status as a scorer, and being one of those generational players, the only numbers Koning really cares about are the ones under Cedarville’s name on the scoreboard.

“At the end of the day ... we just want to win games,” he said.

The Indians have done a lot of that, sitting at 8-1 before Friday’s game. They picked up a first-place vote in the Associ-

ated Press Division-IV poll before losing to Northeastern Jan. 5.

Koning is the leading scorer for Cedarville and No. 6 in the Ohio Heritage Conference at nearly 17 points per game being what Godlove called a “scoring guard” despite running the point. Koning isn’t just about scoring, though. He averages more than 4.5 assists per game, tops in the OHC.

And he is also among the conference leaders in points, field goals made, and free-throw percentage.

That should come as no surprise. If there’s a list of basketball stats leaders, you’ll likely find Koning’s name on it.
